

POST-65 MEDICARE ELIGIBLE RETIREES

The Florida School Retiree Benefits Consortium (FSRBC) is an extension of Duval County Public School's (DCPS) benefit offerings for 65 and older. Medicare-eligible retirees, from Duval County Public School's, are eligible to enroll in high-quality, comprehensive, and competitive Medicare Medical plans. Medicare-eligible retirees and Medicare-eligible spouses from Duval County Public Schools that are enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B are eligible to enroll in the FSRBC program.

Reasons to Consider Enrolling in a FSRBC Plan:

- Plans available through FSRBC generally have lower member out of pocket cost than the plans available in the general marketplace. Other benefits include:
- Group plans have a much richer drug benefit with a broader network and are not available outside of the Consortium
- Comprehensive drug formularies give retirees access to more prescriptions
- National PPO provider networks for group MAPD plans
- MAPD plans start at \$0 monthly premium
- Variety of plan options to meet your health and financial needs
- Enhanced concierge services with weekly virtual classroom sessions and one-on-one educational sessions with FSRBC staff.
- Enhanced payment options with FRS Pension deductions Health insurance subsidy dollars are not
 considered taxable income by FRS if you have your premium dollars deducted from your pension
 check.

FSRBC 2025 Annual Enrollment

- Annual Enrollment will be held from October 28 through November 5, 2024
- The standard Part D benefit has been updated to reflect the Inflation Reduction Act changes that will take effect January 1, 2025. The impact is a redesign of the current Prescription Drug Plan (Part D) plan.
